Notes for Coordinators/Hosts

- LOG runs three type of events: Men to Men; Women to Women; and Men/Women & Friends
- Try to visit the Hosts and plan the event
 - Describe the event for the Web Site and invites using 'gay language'
 - Let Julian know details for mail outs & emails with dates
 - Use your own network and that of the hosts to promote the function – especially local men
 - Provide correct travel details with a map or road directory info
 - Involve COPP Chairpersons & Outright Youth
 - Important to provide re-imburement for costs
 - A charge to assist costs & fundraising with COPP social projects - e.g. reducing discrimination, suicide prevention, etc
 - Volunteers to assist with salads and sweets – different people
 - Sponsors - Running a raffle or not?
 - Road signs to indicate the venue and turn off from the main road (balloons)
- A petty cash system exists for any expenses incurred by hosts
- Good to give the hosts on the day a present
- Chair the Information Session on the day – humour helps
- Set up a 'Meet & Greet Table' with list of guests attending, name labels, membership forms (every one attending is required to be a member)
